



SPRING PLUMBING CHECKLIST



Get your home ready for warmer weather!
A quick seasonal check can help prevent leaks, water damage, and costly repairs.



OUTDOOR FAUCETS & HOSE BIBS

- Turn on outdoor faucets and check for leaks
- Inspect for cracks or damage from winter freezing or exposed PVC water lines.
- Check water pressure and flow consistency
- Ensure hose connections are tight and secure



SPRINKLER & IRRIGATION SYSTEM

- Turn system on gradually and test each zone
- Look for broken, clogged, or misaligned sprinkler heads
- Check for uneven watering or dry spots
- Inspect for leaks or soggy areas in the yard
- Adjust spray direction and coverage as needed



EXTERIOR PLUMBING & DRAINAGE

- Inspect exposed outdoor pipes for cracks, wear, or weather damage.
- Check outdoor shut-off valves for proper operation
- Make sure exterior drains are clear and flowing properly through cleanouts.



QUICK INTERIOR CHECK

- Look under sinks for leaks or moisture
- Test water pressure in faucets and showers
- Listen for running toilets or hidden leaks
- Check for slow drains throughout the home



WARNING SIGNS TO WATCH FOR

- Sudden drop in water pressure
- Unexplained increase in water bill
- Bubbly drain lines or slow draining
- Water pooling around your home
- Persistent dripping or leaks
